

Introduction







and delivereth them. Psalm 34:7*


God's angel sets up a circle of protection around us while we pray. — Message

Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and He bringeth them out of their distresses. Psalm 107:28


Then you called out to GOD in your desperate condition; He got you out in the nick of time. — Message

This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles. Psalm 34:6


When I was desperate, I called out, and God got me out of a tight spot. — Message

and redeemed His people. Luke 1:68*


Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel; he came and set

out of all their troubles. Psalm 34:17*


Is anyone crying for help? GOD is listening, ready to rescue you. — Message

before Him, even into His ears. Psalm 18:6*


A hostile world! I call to God, I cry to God to help me. From His palace He hears my call; my cry brings me right into His presence - a private audience! — Message

Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in Thy presence is fulness of joy; at Thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore. Psalm 16:11


Now you've got my feet on the life path, all radiant from the shining of your face. — Message

These things have I spoken unto you, that My joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full. John 15:11


I've told you these things for a purpose: that My joy might be your joy, and your joy wholly mature. — Message


When Your words showed up, I ate them - swallowed them whole. What a feat!

Count It All Joy

My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into diverse temptations; knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. James 1:2-3

Consider it a sheer gift, friends, when tests and challenges come at you from all sides. You know that under pressure, your faith-life is forced into the open and shows its true colors. So don't try to get out of anything prematurely. — Message


Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. — NASB

Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this world. 1John 4:17


This way, love has the run of the house, becomes at home and mature in us, so that we're free of worry on Judgment Day - our standing in the world is identical with Christ's. — Message

and of a sound mind. 2 Timothy 1:7*


God doesn't want us to be shy with his gifts, but bold and loving

And be ye kind one to another, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you. Ephesians 4:32


Be gentle with one another, sensitive. Forgiving one another as quickly and thoroughly as God in Christ forgave you. — Message

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. — TNIV

*But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into Him in all things,
which is the head, even Christ. Ephesians 4:15*

God wants us to grow up, to know the whole truth and tell it in love - like
Christ in everything. — Message

Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more
and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church. — NLT

Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who
is the head, that is, Christ. — TNIV

*Confession: I'm growing up spiritually in Christ Jesus. He enables
me to speak the truth, deal truthfully, and live
truthfully in all things, doing it with love.*



Fruit Of The Spirit

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23


He brings gifts into our lives, much the same way that fruit appears in an orchard—things like affection for others, exuberance about life, serenity. We develop a willingness to stick with things, a sense of compassion in the heart, and a conviction in the heart, and a conviction that a basic holiness permeates things and people. We find ourselves involved in loyal commitments, not needing to force our way in life, able to marshal and direct our energies wisely. Legalism is helpless to bring this about; it only gets in the way. — Message

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things! — NLT

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. — TNIV

Confession: I'm full of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, gentleness, meekness, generosity, tolerance, self-control, and faithfulness. I bear much fruit.



Forgive And Be Forgiven

And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any; that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. Mark 11:25


And when you assume the posture of prayer, remember that it's not all asking. If you have anything against someone, forgive - only then will your heavenly Father be inclined to also wipe your slate clean of sins. — Message

Whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father who is in heaven will also forgive you your transgressions. — NASB

But when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too. — NLT

Confession: Father, I forgive those who have offended or hurt me. I release them. I ask you to forgive me of my shortcomings and mistakes. Make me like You.



In His Love

*If ye keep My commandments, ye shall abide in My love;
even as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in
His love. John 15:10*


If you keep My commands, you'll remain intimately at home in My love.

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 1 John 4:10

Not that we once upon a time loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as a sacrifice to clear away our sins and the damage they've done to our relationship with God. — Message

In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. — NASB

This is real love - not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. — NLT

This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. — TNIV

Confession: God loves me so much that He sent his Son as a sacrifice for me so I can be forgiven of my sins.



The Greatest Is Love

And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. 1 Corinthians 13:13


But for right now, until that completeness, we have three things to do to lead us toward that consummation: Trust steadily in God, hope unswervingly, love extravagantly. And the best of the three is love. — Message

But now faith, hope, love, abide these three; but the greatest of these is love. — NASB

Three things will last forever - faith, hope, and love - and the greatest of these is love. — NLT

And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love. — TNIV

Confession: I faithfully put my trust in God. I hope in Him without wavering. I walk in extravagant love toward God and my fellow man.



The Love Of Christ

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Romans 8:35


Do you think anyone is going to be able to drive a wedge between us and Christ's love for us? There is no way! Not trouble, not hard times, not hatred, not hunger, not homelessness, not bullying threats, not backstabbing. — Message

Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? — NASB

Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? — NLT

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? — TNIV

Confession: I'm God's favorite child. There is nothing that can separate me from the love of Christ because He loves me with an everlasting love.



Walk in Love

And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savour. Ephesians 5:2


Mostly what God does is love you. Keep company with Him and learn a life of love. Observe how Christ loved us. His love was not cautious but extravagant. He didn't love in order to get something from us but to give everything of Himself to us. Love like that. — Message

And walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma. — NASB

Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God. — NLT

And walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. — TNIV

Confession: I love others as God loves me. I'm not cautious with my love, but give unselfishly of myself. I love extravagantly, just like Jesus.



The Love of God

And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. Romans 5:5

In alert expectancy such as this, we're never left feeling shortchanged. Quite the contrary - we can't round up enough containers to hold everything God generously pours into our lives through the Holy Spirit. — Message

And hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us. — NASB

And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love. — NLT

And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. — TNIV

Confession: I put my hope in Jesus Christ so I'm never disappointed. God's continuously pours His love upon me, through the Holy Spirit.



Love Covers Sin

And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. 1 Peter 4:8


Most of all, love each other as if your life depended on it. Love makes up for practically anything. — Message

Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. — NASB

Most important of all, continue to show deep love for each other, for love covers a multitude of sins. — NLT

Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. — TNIV

Confession: I love others with God's love. I walk in His love which enables me to forgive any offense that tries to come against me.



The Real Life

Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. Jude 21

Staying right at the center of God's love, keeping your arms open and outstretched, ready for the mercy of our Master, Jesus Christ. This is the unending life, the real life! — Message

Keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting anxiously for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life. — NASB

And await the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will bring you eternal life. In this way, you will keep yourselves safe in God's love. — NLT

Keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life. — TNIV

Confession: I guard my heart and keep myself in the love of God where He can reach and bless me, bringing me into real life!



Nothing Separates Us

Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:39


None of these fazes us because Jesus loves us. I'm absolutely convinced that nothing - nothing living or dead, angelic or demonic, today or tomorrow, high or low, thinkable or unthinkable - absolutely nothing can get between us and God's love because of the way that Jesus our Master has embraced us. — Message

Nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. — NASB

No power in the sky above or in the earth below - indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord. — NLT

Neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. — TNIV

Confession: Nothing can separate me from God's love. His love comes to me in the gift of Jesus Christ, my Lord.



Faith Works By Love

For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth anything, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love. Galatians 5:6

For in Christ, neither our most conscientious religion nor disregard of religion amounts to anything. What matters is something far more interior: faith expressed in love. — Message

For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything, but faith working through love. — NASB

For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Romans 8:6


Those who trust God's action in them find that God's Spirit is in them - living and breathing God! — Message

And be renewed in the spirit of your mind. Ephesians 4:23


A life renewed from the inside and working itself into your conduct as God accurately reproduces his character in you. — Message

And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of Him that created him. Colossians 3:10


Now you're dressed in a new wardrobe. Every item of your new way of life is custom-made by the Creator, with his label on it. All the old fashions are obsolete. — Message

He'll be stingy with you as he is with himself... — Message







For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 6:23



Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth labourers into His harvest. Matthew 9:38


“What a huge harvest!” He said to his disciples. “How few workers! On your knees and pray for harvest hands!” — Message

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. John 3:16





Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven. — NASB


But don't rejoice because evil spirits obey you; rejoice because your names are registered in heaven. — NLT




Be Lord over my life according to Romans 10:9-10 which says.
